PROTECTION _____

Impact of the war	> Nearly 41,700 people reportedly killed , including at least 11,355 children ^[1]
	> 1.9 million people forcibly displaced, on average at least once a month
<u>A</u> A	> 66 per cent of structures damaged or destroyed across the Gaza Strip ^[2]
	> Nearly 200 UNRWA facilities hit during the war and at least 563 people killed when sheltering in an UNRWA facility
	> 226 UNRWA team members killed, among 230 UN workers
UNRWA response	> Up to 1 million people sheltering in UNRWA facilities during the war
	> Over 24,300 displaced people received individual psychosocial support for vulnerable protection cases (including child protection, survivors of gender based violence, released detainees, and others)
EDUCATION —	
Impact of the war	> Nearly 660,000 children forced out of school ^[3] , half of whom used to go to UNRWA schools
	 > Over 87 per cent of school buildings will either need full reconstruction or major rehabilitation work to be functional again ^[4] > Over 85 per cent of UNRWA schools hit or damaged, many while sheltering displaced families
UNRWA response	> 500,000 children benefited from psycho-social support activities
	> 9,500 children, 60 per cent of them girls, benefited from back to learning activities in 36 dedicated shelters across the Gaza Strip
HEALTH ———	
Impact of the war	> Over 500 attacks on health workers, patients, hospitals, and other medical infrastructure in Gaza ^[5]
	> Vaccination coverage for routine immunization dropped from 99 per cent to less than 90 per cent due to the war ^[6]
\sim	> Spread of communicable diseases in shelters including hepatitis A, respiratory infections, scabies, lice, and skin rashes
UNRWA response	> 8 out of 27 UNRWA health centres operational, and around 80 medical

WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE

Impact of the war



> Two out of three water desalination plants partially operational ^[7]

- > 70 per cent of water supplied through networks lost due to damage^[8]
- > Hundreds of people sharing a bathroom
- > 395,000 tons of accumulated solid waste and two landfills inaccessible [9]
- UNRWA response
- > Eight water wells maintained and rehabilitated, reaching over 600,000 displaced people with access to water
- > Over 4.6 million litres of water distributed
- > Over 167,100 hygiene kits distributed

NUTRITION AND FOOD PROTECTION -

Impact of the war

> 96 per cent of the population was projected to face crisis level of food insecurity, or worse ^[10]



- > Over 96 per cent of women and children aged 6-23 months not meeting their nutrient requirements ^[11]
- > Nearly 70 per cent of cropland damaged ^[12]
- UNRWA response
- > Over three million bags of flour distributed
 - > Over 208,000 families received UNRWA food parcels
